Proceedings:

1. Vice President Oberschulte called the meeting to order at 0920L.
2. Minutes of the last meeting reviewed by members and approved.
3. Treasurer's Report
 - a. Mr. Saar presented the treasurers report. The current balance of the account(s) \$1876.02.
 - b. The club has been approved for and received a \$500.00 educational grant from Comptons Traditional Bowhunters for the bow-building class
 - c. The club is re-purchasing insurance through Outdorinsurance.com at a price of \$525.00 for the next year.
 - d. The meeting attendees asked when we can combine the two accounts. Mr. Smith said he can't close he old account without Mr. Matt Clark being there to sign the documents. Mr. Smith said he is meeting Mr. Clark at the Credit Union on Tuesday to accomplish it.
 - e. Mr. Saar paid \$75.63 A & D Technical Supply for printing services for 2010 Rendezvous Flyers. There was also an outstanding bill due to A & D Technical Supply discovered. The bill amounts is \$66.92 for 2008 printing services. A motion was made to pay this bill. The motion was approved.
 - f. Mr. Saar said he wants to figure out a way to bring the old members and ask what they did to generate revenue.
 - g. Mr. Saar suggested we have a breakfast again at the rendezvous to generate revenue. President Brooks and Mr. Smith said in the past the breakfast only broke even and didn't make money.
 - h. Mr. Smith said the best way to make money is through the auction. He said bring anything you can to the auction. It will sell.
 - i. The Treasurer's report was approved by members.
4. Rendezvous
 - a. Mr. Smith brought the rendezvous flyers to the meeting. Distribution to various Sporting stores will be done by:

 - f. Vice President Oberschulte will take the 2 bow benches from the club for the bow-building seminar at the Nebraska Bowhunters Association's jamboree at Halsey.
